PRESS RELEASE:

On March 21, 2010 at about 0400 hours the Castle Rock Police Department responded to a report of a vehicle prowler on Allen AV within the city limits of Castle Rock. The reporting party called 911 to report waking up to find someone inside the passenger compartment of his vehicle. When the reporting party went to call 911, the suspect fled the area.

Castle Rock Police and Cowlitz County Deputies searched the area for the subject. During the search for the suspect, another citizen called 911 to report her alarm going off and her vehicle's door open. No one was seen around the vehicle. Police were unable to locate the suspect. He is described as a white male in his 20's with light colored hair. He was last seen wearing a white shirt, blue jeans and a base ball hat.

Throughout the early morning hours and into the next day, the Castle Rock Police Department received numerous other vehicle prowler and theft reports as victims awoke to find their car doors open and items missing. One burglary to a garage and a broken window to a nearby business are also possibly related.

One of the victims reported her backpack stolen from her vehicle. She reports that the backpack contained two hearing aids (valued at \$1700 each) and assorted medical devices for her 3 ½ year old child who suffers from medical problems.
